EU Biodiversity Strategy to 2030

EU Forest Strategy for 2030

3 Billion trees

Improve the quantity and quality of EU forests and strengthen their protection, restoration and resilience – **resilient** and **multifunctional** forests

- Proposed forest monitoring law
 - ► Guidelines on closer-to-nature forest management
 - ➤ <u>Guidelines on biodiversity-friendly afforestation,</u> reforestation and tree planting
 - ➤ <u>Guidelines for defining, mapping, monitoring and</u> strictly protecting EU primary and old-growth forests
 - ➤ <u>Guidance on the development of public and private</u> payment schemes for ecosystem services
- R&I Key driver « In order to strengthen EU cooperation, a research and innovation partnership on forestry will be proposed to overcome the fragmentation of public research efforts in the EU and to reinforce work on research priorities that call for a stronger coordination."

- Addressing multiple functions of forests: climate, biodiversity, bioeconomy etc.
- ❖ EU's greenhouse gas emission reduction target of at least 55% in 2030, as set out in the European Climate Law
- ❖ Promote forest-related interventions in the CAP (2023-2027) and in other EU financial instruments





















Policy context and relevance

Nature Restoration Law

- Put in place restoration measures on 20% all EU land and sea by 2030
- On all EU ecosystems in need of restoration by 2050
- Targets based on existing legislation for specific habitats types including forests
- Specific forest ecosystems restoration targets


- EU Bioeconomy Strategy update in 2025
- Biotechnology and Biomanufacturing Communication
- Primary producers' role in bioeconomy value chains

Carbon removals certification framework

- Carbon farming, such as restoring forests and soils and avoiding soil emissions, and other innovative farming practices
- Binding carbon in longlasting products and materials, such as woodbased construction materials or biochar.
- New business models for foresters



Forestry research under Horizon Europe (2021-24)



Call for stakeholders to join the working group on primary producers



- Circular Bio-based Europe Joint Undertaking (CBE JU): R&I projects to develop inclusive business models for primary producers in biobased value chains
- Objectives of the working group:
 - Enhance the role of primary producers in circular bio-based systems and value chains.
 - Ensure that primary sectors benefit from the economic, social, and environmental opportunities offered by circular and biobased innovations.
- Submit your application by 28 February 2025 at 12.00 (noon) CET.



Candidate European Partnership, Strategic Plan 2025-2027 Forests and Forestry for a Sustainable Future

- Implementation mode: Co-funded European Partnership
- Cluster: 6 (Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment)
- Call for proposals: Draft Cluster 6 Work Programme 2025
- Envisioned duration: 2025-2031 (7 years)
- Tentative EU contribution: 70 M€ (30%) + MS/AC contribution 163 M€ (70%) = 233 M€





Candidate European Partnership, Strategic Plan 2025-2027 Forests and Forestry for a Sustainable Future

Objectives: A research and innovation-oriented transdisciplinary instrument that supports the EU Forest Strategy simultaneously with climate targets and the Biodiversity Strategy.

Expected impacts:

- Stronger consistency between social, environmental and economic dimensions of forests and forestry
- Better understanding of the role of forests in climate change and biodiversity targets
- Improved guidelines on adaptive forestry regimes in European regions
- New knowledge to support major transitions and innovations in the forest-based bioeconomy towards higher added value
- Improved, consistent, comprehensive and timely monitoring of forests
- New green forestry business models

- decide on the next steps





- First SRIA draft published on 16 May: result of first round of regional stakeholder workshops
- Online stakeholder consultation until 7 June

- Final SRIA in autumn 2025
