Challenges

- DSS adapted to local level conditions / needs
- Lack of communication and linkages between sectors (PFOs, forest practitioners, R&D sector, policy level)
- Data overload (focus on data, not on advisory role)
- Low level of awareness among stakeholders on DSS tools
- Abandonment of forest properties
- Lack of EU level forest related policy (Common Forestry Policy)

- Communication & information exchange researchers, ICT, PFOs, forest managers.
