Open innovation - emerged recently as a new **innovation model**.

It encourages companies to use the existing external knowledge rather than reinvent the wheel.

Members are a key element of an open innovation community. They bring ideas and engage in the development of innovative products and services.

Open innovation ecosystems are hubs with networks or communities working around a **common goal**.

The Forest Sector Open Innovation Ecosystem



1. Identify and analyze the strengths, weaknesses, gaps, and opportunities for innovation in the sector.

2 **Develop targeted measures** to enhance innovation capacity by supporting existing networks and creating new synergies.

"The future European Partnership on Forests is expected to allocate resources to cooperate with existing projects, initiatives and other processes in order to support the partnership's goals..." (call description for the partnership, CL6 WP2025).



Step 1: create a WG of relevant stakeholders

- will consist of relevant public and private stakeholders in the quadruple helix
- a broad range of stakeholders will be invited to participate (EUFORE stakeholder hub, Topical European networks: Incredible (NWFP), WoodPoP, EBU, FOREXT etc.)
- promoted openly





Step 2: the planned activities

- To map existing relevant innovation networks and support initiatives in the whole sector for all relevant themes in F&FS according to SRIA
- To highlight innovation **pilot actions** and **initiatives**
- Input through surveys, written statements and meetings in order to produce a final report on *"Recommendations on improvement of the sector's open innovation ecosystem are codesigned"*



Key Takeaways
