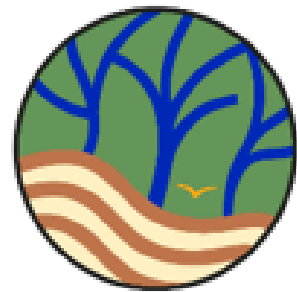

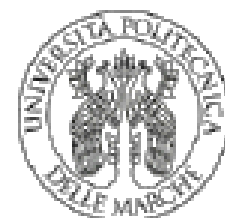

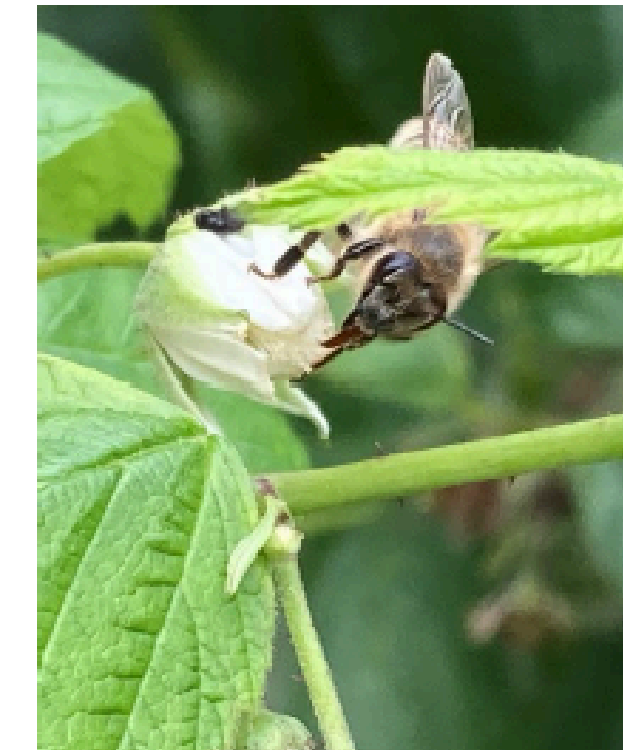

Open discussion led by the chairperson:

1. Links between OG and EU projects

- Similar issues between OptForEu and SlideForMap
- Important to engage with society – different activities in Ogs
- (e.g. forestwalks, network building)
- SUPERB highlighted Transformative Narrative Guide

2. Gaps. Identify research needs

- AI to improve climate model ? Or not ?
- Data needed for models (AI or classical)
- Ecosystem functioning (new assemblages)
- Social research on acceptance of CC adaptation strategies in society
- Need of (rare) data on rare species for assisted migration

3. Knowledge transfer and Advisory systems

- Importance of locally found solutions, no copy paste but inspiring examples
- Replicability and upscaling of restoration strategies -> research
- Need to reform the advisory system (from hierarchical to participatory)

4. Potential for regional/National and cross border collaboration

- Assisted migration, need for genetic resources is cross-border problem (some species do not come from Europe)

5. Financing cooperation

- CAP Strategic Financing offers opportunities for forests national and regional authorities need to put measures forests (“homework for us”)
- But CAP mainly dedicated to Agriculture
- HEU can finance collaboration, transdisciplinarity (eg Foradvise, FOREST4EU, etc)
- Local or National financing can follow the EU funding
